

L.E. Smith Glass

The LE Smith Glass Co. produced décor glass for 98 years. The company passed through many eras in time, producing the popular glass of the day. The mid-century period produced designs that reflected the expanding mind of the 50's and 60's. Smith Glass is Famous for their "Moon & Star" pattern, a re-make of an 1800's pattern by an older company. The design was picked up by many glassmakers of the mid-century, some modified the pattern. Even Fenton Art Glass made a variation of Moon & Star.

Many of Smith's retro art glass items are unidentified. The Giant floor vase shown here looks very much like designs coming from Viking or Fenton. A vase made exactly like this was found with the Smith Glass label still attached. The vase stands

32" tall, the largest from Smith found to date. They made this form in other sizes as well.

Smith Glass made a wide range of popular glass items.
